David brings excellence in choral coaching and conducting, as well as experienced pastoral and educational experience. He will use these, in conjunction with his other duties, as the principal conductor of the Cathedral Choral Society. Over the past year as the

Cathedral's Interim Assistant Organist, David has become well known to the community, has formed excellent bonds, and has earned the respect of the Cathedral's choirs. Following graduation from the University of Toronto with an honours degree in music education, David was awarded a scholarship to study both music history and organ at King's College, London (UK) with Thurston Dart and Lady Susi Jeans. He is an Associate of both the Royal Conservatory of Music and the Royal College of Organists. It was a scholarship from the latter that enabled him to study choral conducting at the renowned Westminster Choir College at Princeton, New Jersey. David has been organist at Trinity-St. Paul's United, Fairlawn United, All Saints Kingsway, and All Souls Willowdale. From 1979 - 1990, he was Associate Organist to John Tuttle at St. Paul's Bloor St. David was also head of the Music Department at Jarvis Collegiate in Toronto until retiring in 1998.
